After repeated delays, the Club is pleased to announce that a decision has been made by the Environment Court confirming the Club's ability to play football across both the Upper and Lower fields at Michaels Avenue Reserve, and under floodlights.

Although the Court and Council are still confirming the exact wording of the conditions of consent, you will be pleased to know that work will resume on completing the Lower field redevelopment over the balance of 2016. In the interim, parts of the Lower fields will be made available for limited footballing activity.

This decision is a very positive step towards the Club's objective of creating a hub for the Club's activities within our community. However, in order to further improve the Club's field capacity, the Club has also secured winter and summer hours of use at the nearby Ngahue Reserve artificial turf complex, as well as at nearby Liston Park in Ellerslie.

Altogether, these successes ensure that the Club can provide quality, sustainable fields for year round use by our growing membership.

Further details will be made available as they come to hand. In the meantime, many thanks to all those people that assisted in securing these valuable facilities for our collective benefit.
