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Site Specific Conditions for Public Usage of Fields & Amenities

Warning - You Are Entering a Mixed Site of Construction and Limited Public Usage Areas

Do Not Enter the Construction Areas Unless You Have an Appointment or Are On Business Related Activities.

Do Not Enter This Site If You Are Not Able to Follow the Pre-Described Site and Public Usage Areas Conditions

Speed Limit for all Public Usage Areas Is **20KPH**

This facility has a mix of walking and vehicle traffic; Vehicles must give way to pedestrians.

Public parking is permitted within the allocated spaces provided. General parking is not permitted within disabled spaces, loading zones or along the sides of roads and carriageways.

All Visitors using the sports fields must first contact their team manager upon entering the site for a detailed health & safety briefing before entering the playing fields

No food of any kind, gum, or drinks other than plain water may be brought onto the artificial turf.

No dogs are permitted on site other than guide dogs.

Coaches or Team Managers that are assigned the responsibility for the well-being of players and supporting personnel, must wear Hi-Visibility Clothing or some sort of easily identifiable item. This person must remain on site until the last person in their charge has left the site. The name of this person or persons must be forwarded to the field manager before commencing usage of the fields.

Coaches or Team Managers are responsible to organize their own qualified First Aid Personnel along with all the necessary First Aid Supplies.

All visitors other than team members, coaches and referees must remain behind the spectator fencing located around the fields, at all times.

All players and support staff must wear approved artificial turf foot wear while using the artificial turf areas.

All players and support staff footwear must be clean and serviceable before entering the fields - use boot brushes supplied around the fields if necessary to remove all foreign debris.



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It is the scheduled team's responsibility to clean-up the field and spectator areas after use. Please make sure that all bottles and general debris are disposed of properly in the bins provided. This common courtesy extends to all practice, training and game fields.

Coaches or managers must walk the field and survey for any safety issues each time you use a field. If you see an issue that raises concern, that cannot be remedied immediately, contact our duty field manager. If there is an issue of immediate danger, leave the area, contact your team officials along with the field manager.

Do not insert any equipment into the artificial turf that will create a hole or divot, and do not bring any chairs or canopies onto the turf.

Toilets and changing rooms are available on this site. It is the responsibility of the hiring team coach or team manager to inspect these facilities before and after allowing players and staff access. If any defects are evident these must be reported to the field manager. Damages incurred during your allocated time will be on charged.

If another scheduled team is waiting to use the field you are on, please leave the area promptly when your scheduled time has lapsed. Do not wait for or expect someone to ask you to leave.

Remember this is a youth rich environment and adoring eyes and ears are tuning in. The fields are no place for profanity.

Coaches and or team managers are responsible for the enforcement of these rules. Please communicate them to players, families and opposing coaches.

In the event of any conflicting use of the fields, please use courtesy in dealing with the other sports teams. Report any conflicts to the fields scheduler or OFC duty Field Manager for resolution.

The OFC appointed Site Manager has the final say over how the fields are used along with short or long term closures of this sports facility. Please be courteous with them and follow their instructions.

It is the responsibility of all visitors to this facility to conduct themselves in a safe and professional manner at all times while on site.

Periodically contractors and maintenance staff may be working within the public usage areas. NO VISITOR may enter these areas.

Visitors are not permitted to take photos of contractors or site staff without obtaining prior permission from the site manager.

These rules are in place to provide a safe environment for all users

Consequently, if a person or persons is reported or observed violating any of these facility safety rules, that person or persons will be asked to cease the violation and if refuses will be asked to leave the site. If the same person or persons repeatedly violates the safety rules, then that person or persons will be excluded further entry to the facility for a time set down by the site manager. If the said person or persons is on site by invitation of a club, then that club will also receive notification of the violation and the resulting actions.
