Dear Members,

Re : Ngahue Reserve Update.

In March this year, I advised you all that an Environment Court decision had been secured, confirming that the Lower Fields at Michaels Ave Reserve would become available for use over the balance of 2016. To complement that, the Club had also secured significant training and game time at Ngahue Reserve (through OFC).

Unfortunately, it has been a frustrating time over the past 4 weeks as a number of maintenance and ongoing construction programming issues at the Ngahue facility have curtailed the Club's ability to utilise that resource.

Oceania Football Federation have now advised us formally that they have closed the Ngahue facility for all of April whilst these issues are fully resolved.

Whilst this decision puts a lot of pressure on a number of Club personnel vested with the responsibility of programming games and training times for all of our 125 teams, not to mention frustration from our teams in being moved around, we believe the end result will be worth it.

Can I extend my thanks to you all for your patience as we move through this phase, we remain focussed on the ultimate objective of securing quality field facilities for our growing membership.
